HB 2386 - Veterinary school students; spaying or neutering dogs and cats; animal shelters

Chairman Aurand told committee we were going to work **HB 2386**.

Eunice Peters, Office of the Revisor of Statutes, explained to the committee the amendment to this bill. (Attachment 1)

Representative Colloton moved to adopt the amendment to HB 2386. It was seconded by Representative Howell. Motion carried.

Representative Loganbill moved to amend Section 3, Line 15. Publication in Register. It was seconded by Representative Osterman. Motion carried.

Representative Colloton moved to pass out HB 2386 as amended. It was seconded by Representative Scapa. Motion carried.

SB 11 - Authorizing transportation of students residing on Fort Leavenworth military reservation

Chairman Aurand moved to include HB 2004 as passed on the House to SB 11. It was seconded by Representative Colloton. Motion carried.

Representative Spalding moved to amend SB 11 regarding only transportation count on SB 11. (Attachment 2). It was seconded by Representative Osterman. Motion carried.

Representative Spalding moved to pass out SB 11 amended. It was seconded by Representative Scapa. Motion carried.

HCR 5010 - School finance; equitable distribution of public school funds in the amount and manner determined by the legislature

Eunice Peters, Office of the Revisor of Statutes explained to the committee the amendment to **HCR 5010**. (Attachment 3)

A question and answer session followed Ms. Peters' explanation.

Chairman Aurand explained to the committee that not enough people were present to vote on this bill. He advised the committee to keep it close because we might meet briefly next week to vote on **HCR 5010**.
