MR. PRESIDENT:

I move to amend **SB 496**, on page 2, following line 35, by inserting:

- "Sec. 2. (a) The provisions of this section shall be known and may be cited as the legislator empowerment and protection program.
- (b) (1) Prior to requesting a bill for introduction that would impact public school curriculum or the provision of finance for public schools, a legislator desiring to make such request shall either:
 - (A) Volunteer for a week in a public school in this state; or
- (B) consult with a team of at least six teaching professionals designated by the state board of education.
- (2) Upon completion of the requirement of paragraph (1), a legislator may request the introduction of a bill that would impact public school curriculum or the provision of finance for public schools.
- (c) To protect legislators from a conflict of interest, a legislator who is the parent of a minor child enrolled in a nonpublic school, including a home school, shall not request for introduction any bill that would divert state moneys from public schools to nonpublic schools.
- (d) This section does not apply to bills requested for introduction by a state agency and approved for introduction by a legislative committee or committee members.";

And by renumbering sections accordingly;

On page 1, in the title, in line 2, after "rights" by inserting "; requiring legislators who request certain curriculum or school finance bills to volunteer at a public school or consult with a

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team of professionals; prohibiting certain legislators from requesting bills that divert state moneys from public schools to private schools"
