

On October 10, 2020 my life and my children's lives were completely shattered. The lives of two other families were also completely shattered. We all lost our husband's in what was supposed to be a short drive to look at investment property. We discovered later that the driver was intoxicated; Almost double the legal limit (which is .08 in KS). The driver didn't stop. He didn't look. He didn't listen and drove through a stop sign at an unmanned railroad crossing, directly into an oncoming train, killing my husband- Kevin Corbin, Troy Hamlin and Brent Moroney. The driver survived. This incident left 7 children (ranging in ages from 2-7 years old) without a father. The ripple effects of devastation and loss have been tremendous!

These incredible men were not only the hearts of our families but also the sole providers of our families. Grief and loss of this magnitude comes with a myriad of challenges. It completely turns your world upside down in every single way; One of those ways being your financial stability.

This bill would hold accused drunk drivers accountable by requiring them to pay child support to the surviving minor children of the parent/s they killed until they reach the age of 18. There is no amount of money that will ever bring these parents back, however this bill can greatly assist in bringing the children impacted by this type of horrific tragedy some sort of assistance throughout their childhood. Today, I urge you to pass Kevin's Honor into law.
