
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2703 by House Committee on Education

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2703 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2703 would add students in the custody of the Secretary for Children and Families to the list of students eligible to be identified to receive at-risk programs and services.

HB 2703 could expand the number of students eligible for at-risk programs and services, which could have an impact on allowable at-risk funds for school districts. According to the Kansas State Department of Education and the Department for Children and Families, enactment of HB 2703 would have no fiscal effect on the respective departments.
