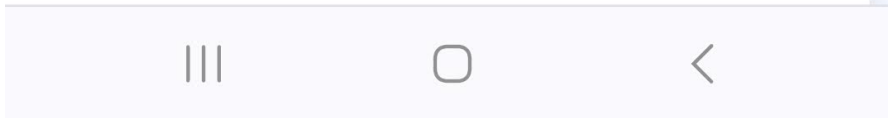

I grew up being called their miracle baby because I wasn't even supposed to make it to birth. My attempt and her seeing everything seriously broke her and I can tell. She hasn't stopped breathing down my neck since and she has to call me every single day to soothe her anxiety of me doing it again. I cannot vent even just about everyday school stress that is the least of my problems without her going overboard with worry. I used to be able to vent to her, but now I keep everything to myself even more than I did before my attempt. Idk how hard this most likely successful attempt will truly send her.
