Re: HB 2335—Grants for qualified track maintenance

Dear Rep Francis and Members of the Committee:

The Sheet Metal Air Rail and Transportation Workers (SMART) is NEUTRAL on HB 2335.

HB 2335 authorizes loans or grants for qualified track maintenance; and track maintenance as a qualifier to the rail service improvement fund.

We agree these funds are beneficial to the Kansas economy but ask that amendments be made defining railroads that qualify for the program. We also ask that the Federal Railroad Administration's definition of an industry track be included giving clarity to the types of projects and scope of the legislation.
