Subject: HB 2830 - Prescribing documentation requirements to determine eligibility for any benefit derived from a service-connected disability.

House Bill 2830 limits the documentation required to determine eligibility for benefits derived from a service-connected disability.

Section 1 defines the terms service-connected and veteran. It also states that no state agency or municipality shall request or demand any other document to determine eligibility for a benefit derived from a service-connected disability, except for the six forms of documentation listed in the bill. Those documents include a U.S. passport, a veterans health identity card, a veterans identification card, a common access card or any department of defense identity card.

This bill shall take effect on July 1, 2024, upon publication in the statute book.
