
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2127 by House Committee on Judiciary

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2127 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2127 would eliminate a requirement that the first publication of a notice of a probate hearing must be made within ten days after an order fixing the time and place of the hearing. The bill would also change the time when the hearing must be set from not earlier than seven days nor later than 14 days to ten days after the date of the last publication of notice. The bill would require that the notice a representative must give prior to a public sale must include the time, terms, and place of sale. HB 2127 would change the time when the sale must be set from not earlier than seven days nor later than 14 days to ten days after the date of the last publication of notice.

The Office of Judicial Administration states enactment of HB 2127 would have a negligible fiscal effect on Judicial Branch operations.
