

Goal: Challenge the perception of Kansas in both our history and our landscape

- State founded on a cause (free state history), diversity of people
- Diverse landscape
- Challenge visitors to think about their own history
- Consider cases for communities to display their history
- Building does not lend itself to comprehensive history exhibits so focus on iconic documents or artifacts, Kansas art work, etc.
- Committee agrees with proposed progression of moving from photographs to art to artifacts
 - Agreed to examples of artifacts

Would like to see documentary film on the Capitol

Strongly urge interactivity through technology (need wiring)

- Interactive timeline
- Interactive map
- Back-up and supplement the exhibits online

Issue of raising private funds and donor recognition

- Texas allows no plaques
- Issue of possible donors influence over product
- Idea of 1 year tax credits
- Recommend that a legislative committee (joint committee on building construction) work with us to define donor recognition in the Capitol
