A.G. coordinates training in human trafficking

Establishes a human trafficking advisory board

Establishes a human trafficking victim assistance fund

Creates the crime of Commerical sexual exploitation of a child (Level 5 person

Felony) moves to Level 2 person when the subject has previous conviction for violating this section

Commercial sexual exploitation of a child is an off-grid person felony when the

offender is 18 and the victim is less than 14 years of age

Prostitution is now called selling sexual relations (It is a defense if the defendant was the subject of human trafficking)

Promoting the sale of sexual relations is now a Level 9 person felony (Up from a class A misdemeanor)

Fines are set in the \$2500.00-\$5000.00 range

The bill covers offender registration, expungements, background checks,

Criteria for departing from the sentencing guidleines regarding human trafficking and aggravated human trafficking

Adds human trafficking, sexual exploitation of a child, commercial expolitation of a child, and buying or selling sexual relations to the list of crimes

"wiretaps" can be used as an investigative tool
