

- Kansas legislation (K.S.A. 74-9301 et seq.) was passed in 1990 authorizing the creation of the Information Network of Kansas, Inc. (INK).
- In 1991, INK awarded Kansas Information Consortium, LLC. (now a subsidiary of NIC Inc., [NASDAQ: EGOV]) the network manager contract and began eGovernment operations.
