Kansas House Bill 2459

Introduction: Good morning Mister Chair and Committee Members. I am Martin Dempsey a lifelong motorcycle enthusiast and Kansas resident. I am an experienced motorcycle rider with over 40 years of riding enjoyment. I am also a retired Air Force Chief Master Sergeant with 24 years active duty.

I characterize my riding experience as enjoyment primarily because of the motorcycle education I received while on active duty. The education and safety training go far beyond the basic familiarity of riding principles most states require to operate a motorcycle. Although I had four years of experience under my belt prior to entering the service, the training I received while taking the service connected training opened up an entire new attitude while I rode my motorcycle.

The constant safety awareness and defensive driving techniques have kept me safe for the past 30 years.
