The hearing opened on HB 2420—Cities; bonded debt limits.

Representative James P. Fawcett gave background and testified as a proponent to <u>HB 2420</u>. He explained that adoption of <u>HB 2420</u> would allow Junction City to meet its debt payments without the need for further bond restructuring, hold property taxes to current levels, and provide the city with some capacity to borrow for day-to-day operational and critical capital investment needs over the next seven years (<u>attachment 1</u>). Gerry Vernon, Junction City Manager, also testified as a proponent of the bill (<u>attachment 2</u>). Written testimony in favor of the bill was submitted by Dr. Pat Landes, Mayor of Junction City, (<u>attachment 3</u>) and Cheryl Beatty, Junction City Finance Director (<u>attachment 4</u>).
