## **REPORTS OF STANDING COMMITTEES**

## MR. PRESIDENT:

The Committee on **Education** recommends **SB 51** be amended on page 1, in line 5, by striking all after "(a)"; by striking all in lines 6 through 11 and inserting "All school districts shall consider adopting a policy regarding the administration of over-the-counter medications to students enrolled in such school district. If such a policy is adopted the board of education may designate which over-the-counter medications may be administered pursuant to such policy, and may decide whether the written authorization of a parent or legal guardian shall be required prior to the administration of such over-the-counter medication."; in line 12, after "require" by inserting "or prohibit requiring"; in line 13, by striking "dispensing" and inserting "administering"; in line 16, by striking "dispense" and inserting "administer"; in line 18, by striking "dispense" and inserting "administer"; following line 24 by inserting:

"(e) Any policy adopted pursuant to this section shall be reviewed by the board of education of such school district at least once every three years. Upon completing its review, the board of education shall amend the policy, if necessary, and either adopt such policy, as amended or without amendment, or rescind such policy.";

And by redesignating the remaining subsections accordingly; and the bill be passed as amended.
