SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2191 by House Committee on Education

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2191 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2191 would increase the term of employment threshold requirement needed to attain tenure for teachers for school districts, area vocational-technical schools and community colleges. The bill would increase the amount of time that a teacher must work from three to five consecutive years. In addition, the bill would increase the time for those teachers who have had previous tenure with a school district, area vocational-technical school or community college from two to three consecutive years of employment.

According to the Department of Education, enactment of HB 2191 would have no fiscal effect.
