SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2751 by House Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2751 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2751 would amend current law concerning private land that is made available to the public for recreation. The bill would specify that nothing in current law should be understood as granting an easement over the land by the owner or by adverse possession.

Passage of HB 2751 would have no fiscal effect.
