
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 104 by Senate Committee on Judiciary

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 104 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 104 would amend the Kansas Tort Claims Act by removing *Kansas Administrative Regulations* citations related to charitable health care providers that provide dental services and replacing the citations with the phrase “rules and regulations adopted by the Kansas Dental Board.”

The Kansas Department of Health and Environment and the Kansas Dental Board indicate that passage of SB 104 would have no fiscal effect.
