SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 188 by Senate Committee on Natural Resources

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 188 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 188 would amend current law to expand the Kansas Department of Health and Environment's authority to approve the unpermitted disposal of demolished buildings or structures at, adjacent to, or near the site of the building or structure. Current law authorizes unpermitted disposal of building materials only on the site where the building was located. The bill would add additional evaluation criteria for the disposal to protect public safety, proposed redevelopment plans for the site, and the disposal capacity of nearby permitted landfills.

The bill would have no fiscal effect on the Department of Health and Environment.
