SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 341 by Senate Committee on Transportation

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 341 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 341 would dissolve, as a corporate body, any city that has received public funding from the Environmental Protection Agency through the Kansas Department of Health and Environment relating to the buyout and relocation of its residents after such residents have been relocated. The usual administrative requirements in current law regarding the dissolution of cities would not apply.

Enactment of the bill would have no fiscal effect.
