1 AN ACT concerning law enforcement; relating to the local law enforcement
2 training reimbursement fund; amending K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 74-5620 and
3 repealing the existing section.

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 74-5620 is hereby amended to read as
7 follows: 74-5620. (a) There is hereby created in the state treasury the local law
8 enforcement training reimbursement fund. All expenditures from the local law
9 enforcement training fund shall: (1) Be distributed to municipalities which
10 participated in local law enforcement training programs, certified by the
11 commission, which existed prior to January 1, 1992, in accordance with a
12 distribution formula developed by the commission; (2) not exceed more than
13 100% of the actual training costs incurred by the municipality in participating
14 in the local law enforcement training program; and (3) be distributed for basic
15 law enforcement training and not be for any type of continuing law
16 enforcement training education programs. ~~No money shall be expended from
17 this fund prior to January 1, 1993.~~ Such distribution formula shall provide that
18 distribution be based on the number of individuals trained and the cost per
19 individual trained of each such municipality. Any such distributions shall be
20 reviewed on a year-to-year basis and adjusted accordingly pursuant to the
21 criteria specified in this section. The commission shall conduct a review of all
22 local law enforcement training programs in which municipalities receiving
23 expenditures pursuant to this act are participating and shall require that all
24 such law enforcement training programs report their costs in a standardized
25 format prescribed by the commission. *Expenditures from the local law
26 enforcement training reimbursement fund shall be made in accordance with
27 appropriation acts upon warrants of the director of accounts and reports
28 issued pursuant to vouchers approved by the commission or by a person or
29 persons designated by the commission.*

30 (b) This section shall be part of and supplemental to the Kansas law
31 enforcement training act.

32 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 74-5620 is hereby repealed.

33 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
34 publication in the statute book.
