Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. Section 93 of chapter 136 of the 2010 Session Laws of Kansas is hereby amended to read as follows: Sec. 93. (a) Burglary is, without authority, entering into or remaining within any:

- (1) Dwelling, with intent to commit a felony, theft or sexual battery specified offense therein;
- (2) building, manufactured home, mobile home, tent or other structure which is not a dwelling, with intent to commit a felony, theft or sexual battery specified offense therein; or
- (3) vehicle, aircraft, watercraft, railroad car or other means of conveyance of persons or property, with intent to commit a felony, theft or sexual battery specified offense therein.
- (b) Aggravated burglary is, without authority, entering into or remaining within any building, manufactured home, mobile home, tent or other structure, or any vehicle, aircraft, watercraft, railroad car or other means of conveyance of persons or property in which there is a human being with intent to commit a felony, theft or sexual battery specified offense therein.
 - (c) (1) Burglary as defined in:
 - (A) Subsection (a)(1) is a severity level 7, person felony;
 - (B) subsection (a)(2) is a severity level 7, nonperson felony; and
 - (C) subsection (a)(3) is a severity level 9, nonperson felony.
- (2) Aggravated burglary is a severity level 5, person felony.
- (d) As used in this section, "specified offense" means:
- (1) A felony, theft or sexual battery;
- 30 (2) domestic battery, as defined in section 49 of chapter 136 of the 31 2010 Session Laws of Kansas;
- 32 (3) stalking, as defined in section 62 of chapter 136 of the 2010 33 Session Laws of Kansas; and
- 34 (4) violation of a protective order, as defined in section 149 of 35 chapter 136 of the 2010 Session Laws of Kansas.
