AN ACT concerning premises liability; relating to recreational purposes; 1 2 relating to noncommercial aviation; amending K.S.A. 58-3202 and repealing the existing section. 3 4 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: Section 1. K.S.A. 58-3202 is hereby amended to read as follows: 58-6 3202. As used in this act: (a) "Land" means land, roads, water, 7 watercourses, private ways and buildings, structures, and machinery or 8 9 equipment when attached to the realty and includes agricultural and 10 nonagricultural land. 11 (b) "Owner" means the possessor of a fee interest, a tenant, lessee, 12 occupant or person in control of the premises. (c) "Recreational purpose" includes, but is not limited to, any of the 13 following, or any combination thereof: Hunting, fishing, swimming, 14 boating, camping, picnicking, hiking, pleasure driving, nature study, 15 16 water skiing, winter sports, noncommercial aviation activities and viewing or enjoying historical, archaeological, scenic, or scientific sites. 17 (d) "Charge" means the admission price or fee asked in return for 18 19 invitation or permission to enter or go upon the land. "Agricultural land" means land suitable for use in farming and 20 (e) 21 includes roads, water, watercourses and private ways located upon or 22 within the boundaries of such agricultural land and buildings, structures 23 and machinery or equipment when attached to such agricultural land. 24 "Farming" means the cultivation of land for the production of (f)25 agricultural crops, the raising of poultry, the production of eggs, the production of milk, the production of fruit or other horticultural crops, 26 27 grazing or the production of livestock. (g) "Nonagricultural land" means all land other than agricultural 28 29 land K.S.A. 58-3202 is hereby repealed. 30 Sec 2 This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 31 Sec. 3.
