1 AN ACT making and concerning appropriations for the fiscal years ending  
2 June 30, 2011, ~~and June 30, 2012, for the department of~~ [June 30,  
3 2012, and June 30, 2013, for state agencies;] education; authorizing  
4 certain transfers, capital improvement projects and fees, imposing  
5 certain restrictions and limitations, and directing or authorizing certain  
6 receipts, disbursements and acts incidental to the foregoing.

7  
8 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

9 Section 1. (a) For the fiscal years ending June 30, 2011, ~~and June 30,~~  
10 2012, **and June 30, 2013**, appropriations are hereby made, restrictions and  
11 limitations are hereby imposed, and transfers, capital improvement  
12 projects, fees, receipts, disbursements and acts incidental to the foregoing  
13 are hereby directed or authorized as provided in this act.

14 **(b) The agencies named in this act are hereby authorized to**  
15 **initiate and complete the capital improvement projects specified and**  
16 **authorized by this act or for which appropriations are made by this**  
17 **act, subject to the restrictions and limitations imposed by this act.**

18 **(c) This act shall not be subject to the provisions of subsection (a)**  
19 **of K.S.A. 75-6702, and amendments thereto.**

20 **(d) The appropriations made by this act shall not be subject to**  
21 **the provisions of K.S.A. 46-155, and amendments thereto.**

23 DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION

24 (a) (1) During the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, on or before ~~April~~  
25 ~~15 June 1,~~ 2011, the commissioner of education, the director of legislative  
26 research and the director of the budget shall jointly determine the amount  
27 of moneys that are required to satisfy the maintenance of state financial  
28 support provisions of the federal individuals with disabilities education  
29 act, as amended, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, based on recent  
30 estimates and other available information pertaining thereto, and shall  
31 jointly certify the amount so determined to the director of accounts and  
32 reports.

33 ~~(2) During the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, upon receipt of such~~

1 joint certification pursuant to subsection (a)(1), the director of accounts  
2 and reports shall transfer the amount prescribed in such certification from  
3 the KPERS— employer contributions account of the state general fund to  
4 the special education services aid account of the state general fund.

5 ~~(3) On or after July 1, 2011, or as soon thereafter as moneys are~~  
6 ~~available therefor, the director of accounts and reports shall transfer the~~  
7 ~~amount prescribed in such joint certification, pursuant to subsection (a)(1),~~  
8 ~~from the general state aid account of the state general fund to the KPERS—~~  
9 ~~employer contributions account of the state general fund.~~

10 **(2) On June 1, 2011, if the amount certified by joint certification**  
11 **pursuant to subsection (a)(1) is more than \$21,240,000, the director of**  
12 **accounts and reports shall determine the difference between**  
13 **\$21,240,000 and the amount so certified and, on June 1, 2011, shall**  
14 **transfer the amount of such difference from the KPERS – employer**  
15 **contributions account of the state general fund of the above agency to**  
16 **the special education services aid account of the state general fund of**  
17 **the above agency.**

18 **(3) (A) On June 3, 2011, of the \$291,602,545 appropriated for the**  
19 **above agency for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, by section 79(a)**  
20 **of chapter 165 of the 2010 Session Laws of Kansas from the state**  
21 **general fund in the KPERS – employer contributions account, the sum**  
22 **determined by the director of accounts and reports as prescribed in**  
23 **subsection (a)(3)(B) is hereby lapsed.**

24 **(B) On or before June 3, 2011, the director of accounts and**  
25 **reports shall determine the sum equal to \$69,200,000 reduced by the**  
26 **amount equal to the amount transferred on June 3, 2011, from the**  
27 **KPERS – employer contributions account of the state general fund of**  
28 **the above agency to the special education services aid account of the**  
29 **state general fund of the above agency pursuant to subsection (a)(2), if**  
30 **any amount is so transferred by the director of accounts and reports.**

31 **(4) At the same time that such joint certification is transmitted to the**  
32 **director of accounts and reports pursuant to subsection (a)(1), the**  
33 **commissioner of education, the director of legislative research and the**  
34 **director of the budget shall jointly transmit a copy of such certification to**  
35 **the speaker of the house of representatives, the speaker pro tem of the**  
36 **house of representatives, the majority leader of the house of**  
37 **representatives, the minority leader of the house of representatives, the**  
38 **chairperson of the committee on appropriations of the house of**  
39 **representatives, the chief clerk of the house of representatives, the**  
40 **president of the senate, the vice-president of the senate, the majority leader**  
41 **of the senate, the minority leader of the senate, the chairperson of the**  
42 **committee on ways and means of the senate and the secretary of the**  
43 **senate.**

1 (b) There is appropriated for the above agency from the state  
2 general fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the following:

3 Special education services aid.....\$21,240,000

4 (c) (1) On July 1, 2011, of the \$1,902,775,680 appropriated for the  
5 above agency for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012, by section 56(a)  
6 of 2011 Senate Bill No. 2383 from the state general fund in the general  
7 state aid account, the sum determined by the director of accounts and  
8 reports as prescribed in subsection (c)(2) is hereby lapsed.

9 (2) On or before July 1, 2011, the director of accounts and reports  
10 shall determine the sum equal to \$21,240,000 reduced by the aggregate  
11 of (A) the amount of \$9,322,755 plus (B) the amount equal to the  
12 amount transferred on June 3, 2011, from the KPERS – employer  
13 contributions account of the state general fund of the above agency to  
14 the special education services aid account of the state general fund of  
15 the above agency pursuant to subsection (a)(2), if any amount is so  
16 transferred by the director of accounts and reports.

17 (d) There is appropriated for the above agency from the state  
18 general fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012, the following:

19 KPERS – employer contributions.....\$69,200,000

22 (a) On the effective date of this act, the expenditure limitation  
23 established for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, by the state  
24 finance council on the abstracters' fee fund of the abstracters' board  
25 of examiners is hereby decreased from \$24,088 to \$23,419.

39 registration board is hereby decreased from \$35,750 to \$16,800.

5 (a) On the effective date of this act, there is appropriated for the  
6 above agency from the following special revenue fund or funds for the  
7 fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, all moneys now or hereafter lawfully

9 expenditures other than refunds authorized by law shall not exceed  
10 the following:

- 11 Harold Rogers prescription federal fund.....No limit
- 12 NASPER grant federal fund.....No limit
- 13 Non-federal gifts and grants fund.....No limit

14 Provided, That the state board of pharmacy is authorized to apply  
15 for and to accept grants and may accept donations, bequests or gifts  
16 from any non-federal source: Provided, however, That all moneys  
17 received for such grants, donations, bequests or gifts shall be remitted  
18 to the state treasurer in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-  
19 4215, and amendments thereto: Provided further, That, upon receipt  
20 of each such remittance, the state treasurer shall deposit the entire  
21 amount in the state treasury to the credit of the non-federal gifts and  
22 grants fund: And provided further, That all expenditures from this  
23 fund shall be made in accordance with appropriation acts upon  
24 warrants of the director of accounts and reports issued pursuant to  
25 vouchers approved by the president of the state board of pharmacy or  
26 a person designated by the president.

42 official hospitality from the technical professions fee fund of the state  
43 board of technical professions is hereby increased from \$500 to \$1,000.

13 children's initiatives fund.

16       (a) On the effective date of this act, of the \$2,470,809  
17 appropriated for the above agency for the fiscal year ending June 30,  
18 2011, by section 114(a) of chapter 165 of the 2010 Session Laws of  
19 Kansas from the state general fund in the restructuring debt service  
20 account, the sum of \$158,816 is hereby lapsed.

21       (b) On the effective date of this act, of the \$16,271,413  
22 appropriated for the above agency for the fiscal year ending June 30,  
23 2011, by section 114(a) of chapter 165 of the 2010 Session Laws of  
24 Kansas from the state general fund in the statehouse improvements –  
25 debt service account, the sum of \$53,840 is hereby lapsed.

26       (c) (1) In addition to the other purposes for which expenditures  
27 may be made by the department of administration from moneys  
28 appropriated from the state general fund or any special revenue fund  
29 for fiscal year 2011 for the department of administration, as  
30 authorized by chapter 6 or chapter 165 of the 2010 Session Laws of  
31 Kansas or by this or other appropriation act of the 2011 regular  
32 session of the legislature, expenditures shall be made by the secretary  
33 of administration for fiscal year 2011 to review the state real property  
34 inventory prepared pursuant to section 61(r) of chapter 165 of the  
35 2010 Session Laws of Kansas, evaluate the state real property, and  
36 prepare from such inventory and other information a prioritized  
37 report of 10% of state real property that could be sold, subject to  
38 existing restrictions: Provided further, That, on or before March 31,  
39 2011, the secretary of administration shall provide a copy of such  
40 prioritized report to the governor, the chief clerk of the house of  
41 representatives, the secretary of the senate, and the chairs of the  
42 committee on appropriations of the house of representatives and the  
43 committee on ways and means of the senate.

1 (2) As used in this subsection, "state real property" includes each  
2 tract of real property owned by the state of Kansas, or any state  
3 agency, as defined by K.S.A. 75-3701, and amendments thereto, and  
4 includes all buildings, facilities and other improvements thereon.

6 **OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE HEARINGS**

7 (a) In addition to the other purposes for which expenditures may  
8 be made by the office of administrative hearings from moneys  
9 appropriated in the administrative hearings office fund for fiscal year  
10 2011 for the office of administrative hearings as authorized by this or  
11 other appropriation act of the 2011 regular session of the legislature,  
12 expenditures may be made by the office of administrative hearings  
13 from moneys appropriated in the administrative hearings office fund  
14 for fiscal year 2011 for official hospitality: Provided, That  
15 expenditures from the administrative hearings office fund for fiscal  
16 year 2011 for official hospitality shall not exceed \$100.

18 **CITIZENS' UTILITY RATEPAYER BOARD**

19 (a)(1) On and after the effective date of this act, notwithstanding  
20 the provisions of section 47(c) of chapter 124 of the 2009 Session Laws  
21 of Kansas or any other statute, no expenditures shall be made for  
22 fiscal year 2011 from the utility regulatory fee fund by the citizens'  
23 utility ratepayer board of the amount equal to the final aggregate  
24 amount of unexpended and unencumbered expenditure authority for  
25 fiscal year 2010, pursuant to and as authorized for expenditure for  
26 fiscal year 2011 as provided by section 47(c) of chapter 124 of the 2009  
27 Session Laws of Kansas, and, on the effective date of this act, the  
28 provisions of section 47(c) of chapter 124 of the 2009 Session Laws of  
29 Kansas are hereby declared to be null and void and shall have no force  
30 and effect.

31 (2) On and after the effective date of this act, during the fiscal  
32 year ending June 30, 2011, in addition to other purposes for which  
33 expenditures may be made by the citizens' utility ratepayer board  
34 from the utility regulatory fee fund for fiscal year 2011 as authorized  
35 by chapter 6 or chapter 165 of the 2010 Session Laws of Kansas or by  
36 this or other appropriation act of the 2011 regular session of the  
37 legislature, notwithstanding the provisions of any other statute, if the  
38 total expenditures authorized to be expended on contracts for  
39 professional services by the citizens' utility ratepayer board by the  
40 expenditure limitation prescribed by section 47(a) of chapter 124 of  
41 the 2009 Session Laws of Kansas are not expended or encumbered for  
42 fiscal year 2010, then the amount equal to the amount of such  
43 expenditure authority for fiscal year 2010 remaining may be expended

1 from the utility regulatory fee fund for fiscal year 2011 pursuant to  
2 contracts for professional services and any such expenditure for fiscal  
3 year 2011 shall be in addition to any expenditure limitation imposed  
4 on the utility regulatory fee fund for fiscal year 2011.

37 carrier license fees fund and the conservation fee fund, in the  
38 aggregate, is hereby increased from \$16,468,621 to \$16,628,381.

41 all moneys now or hereafter lawfully credited to and available in such

3 limited to, (1) conducting investigations of illegal gambling operations  
4 or activities, (2) participating in illegal gaming in order to collect or  
5 purchase evidence as part of an undercover investigation into illegal  
6 gambling operations, and (3) acquiring information or making  
7 contacts leading to illegal gaming activities: Provided, however, That  
8 all moneys that are expended for any such evidence purchase,  
9 information acquisition or similar investigatory purpose or activity  
10 from whatever funding source and that are recovered shall be  
11 deposited in the state treasury in accordance with the provisions of  
12 K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto, and shall be credited to the  
13 illegal gambling enforcement fund.

14 (b) On the effective date of this act, the director of accounts and  
15 reports shall transfer \$5,000 from the state racing fund of the Kansas  
16 racing and gaming commission to the illegal gambling enforcement  
17 fund of the Kansas racing and gaming commission.
