AN ACT concerning feral swine; amending K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 47-1809 1 2 and repealing the existing section. 3 4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 5 Section 1. K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 47-1809 is hereby amended to read as follows: 47-1809. (a) As used in this section, "feral swine" means any 6 7 untamed or undomesticated hog, boar or pig; swine whose reversion from 8 the domesticated state to the wild state is apparent; or an otherwise freely 9 roaming swine having no visible tags, markings or characteristics indicating that such swine is from a domestic herd, and reasonable inquiry 10 11 within the area does not identify an owner. Feral swine includes members 12 of the species sus scrofa lineas, including, but not limited to, swine 13 commonly known as old world swine, Russian boar or European boar. 14 (b) No person shall import, transport or possess live feral swine in 15 this state (c) No person shall intentionally or knowingly release any hog, boar, 16 17 pig or swine to live in a wild or feral state upon public or private land. 18 (d) No person shall engage in, sponsor, instigate, assist or profit from 19 the release, killing, wounding or attempted killing or wounding of feral 20 swine for the purpose of sport, pleasure, amusement or production of a 21 trophy. 22 (e) Violation of subsection (b) or (c) may result in a civil penalty in 23 the amount of not less than \$1,000 nor more than \$5,000 for each suchviolation. In the case of a continuing violation, every day such violation 24 25 continues shall be deemed a separate violation. 26 (f) Violation of subsection (d) may result in a civil penalty of not less 27 than \$250 nor more than \$2,500 for each such violation. 28 (g) Any duly authorized agent of the livestock commissioner, upon a 29 finding that any person, or agent or employee thereof, has violated any of the provisions stated above, may impose a civil penalty upon such person 30 31 as provided in this section. 32 (h) No civil penalty shall be imposed pursuant to this section except upon the written order of the duly authorized agent of the livestock-33 commissioner to the person who committed the violation. Such order shall 34 35 state the violation, the penalty to be imposed and the right of the person to appeal to the commissioner. Any such person, within 20 days after-36

- 1 notification, may make written request to the commissioner for a hearing
- 2 in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas administrative procedure
- act. The commissioner shall affirm, reverse or modify the order and shall
  specify the reasons therefor.

5 (i) Any person aggrieved by an order of the commissioner made
 6 under this section may appeal such order to the district court in the manner
 7 provided by the Kansas judicial review aet.

8 (j) Any eivil penalty recovered pursuant to the provisions of this-9 section shall be remitted to the state treasurer in accordance with the-10 provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto. Upon receipt of 11 each such remittance, the state treasurer shall deposit the entire amount in 12 the state treasury to the credit of the state general fund.

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(e) Violation of this section is a class C nonperson misdemeanor.

17 (<del>()</del>(g) The provisions of this section shall not be construed to prevent 18 owners or legal occupants of land, the employees of such owners or legal 19 occupants or persons designated by such owners or legal occupants from 20 killing any feral swine when found on their premises or when destroying 21 property. Such designees shall have a permit issued by the livestock 22 commissioner in their possession at the time of the killing of the feral 23 swine.
