1 AN ACT concerning crimes, criminal procedure and punishment; relating
2 to payment of board of indigents' services fees; relating to parole
3 revocation proceedings; amending K.S.A. 22-4529 and repealing the
4 existing section.

6 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

7 Section 1. K.S.A. 22-4529 is hereby amended to read as follows: 22-
8 4529. Any defendant entitled to counsel pursuant to K.S.A. 22-4503 or
9 subsection (b) of 22-3716, and amendments thereto, shall pay ~~an a~~
10 *separate* application fee in the amount of \$50 ~~for the period commencing~~
11 ~~on the effective date of this act and ending on June 30, 2004, and the~~
12 ~~amount of \$100 on or after July 1, 2004,~~ to the clerk of the district court. If
13 it appears to the satisfaction of the court that payment of the application
14 fee will impose manifest hardship on the defendant, the court may waive
15 payment of all or part of the application fee. All moneys received pursuant
16 to this section shall be remitted to the state treasurer in accordance with the
17 provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto. Upon receipt of
18 each such remittance, the state treasurer shall deposit the entire amount in
19 the state treasury to the credit of the indigents' defense services fund. If the
20 defendant is acquitted or the case is dismissed, any application fee paid
21 pursuant to this section shall be remitted to the defendant.

22 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 22-4529 is hereby repealed.

23 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
24 publication in the statute book.
