## HOUSE BILL No. 2502

AN ACT concerning agriculture; relating to swine production facilities and 2 establishment procedures; amending K.S.A. 17-5907 and 17-5908 and repealing the existing sections.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 17-5907 is hereby amended to read as follows: 17-7 5907. (a) (1) The board of county commissioners, by resolution, may 8 permit or deny a dairy production facility, as defined in K.S.A. 17-5903, 9 and amendments thereto, to be established within the county. Such resolution shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in 10 11 the official county newspaper. The resolution shall take effect 60 days after 12 final publication unless a valid petition in opposition to the same is filed.

13 (2) If within 60 days of the final publication of the resolution, a valid 14 protest petition to submit the resolution to the qualified voters of the 15 county is signed by qualified electors of the county equal in number to not less than  $\frac{5\%}{10\%}$  5% of the electors of the county who voted for the 16 17 office of secretary of state at the last preceding general election at which such office was elected and is filed with the county election officer, the 18 19 county election officer shall submit the question, as established in 20 subsection (c), of whether a dairy production facility shall be allowed to be 21 established in such county at the next countywide state, county or special 22 election.

23 (b) (1) The board of county commissioners, upon a petition filed in accordance with paragraph (b)(2), shall submit to the qualified electors of 24 25 the county a proposition to permit a dairy production facility, as defined in 26 K.S.A. 17-5903, and amendments thereto, to be established within the 27 county.

28 (2) A petition to submit a proposition to the qualified voters of a 29 county pursuant to this section shall be filed with the county election officer. The petition shall be signed by qualified electors of the county 30 equal in number to not less than 5% 10% 5% of the electors of the county 31 32 who voted for the office of secretary of state at the last preceding general 33 election at which such office was elected. The following shall appear on 34 the petition:

35 "We request an election to determine whether a corporation, trust, limited liability company, limited partnership or corporate partnership, 36

other than a family farm corporation, authorized farm corporation, limited
 liability agricultural company, limited agricultural partnership, family
 trust, authorized trust or testamentary trust shall be allowed to, either
 directly or indirectly, own, acquire or otherwise obtain or lease any
 agricultural land in \_\_\_\_\_ county for the purpose of establishing a
 dairy production facility."

7 (3) Upon the submission of a valid petition calling for an election 8 pursuant to this subsection, the county election officer shall submit the 9 question, as established in subsection (c), of whether a dairy production 10 facility shall be allowed to be established in such county at the next 11 countywide election which occurs more than 60 days after the petition is 12 filed with the county election officer.

(c) In any election established pursuant to this section, the followingshall appear on the ballot:

15 "Shall a corporation, trust, limited liability company, limited 16 partnership or corporate partnership, other than a family farm corporation, 17 authorized farm corporation, limited liability agricultural company, limited 18 agricultural partnership, family trust, authorized trust or testamentary trust 19 be allowed to, either directly or indirectly, own, acquire or otherwise 20 obtain or lease any agricultural land in county for the purpose of 21 establishing a dairy production facility? Such facility shall be in 22 compliance with rules and regulations of the Kansas department of 23 health and environment, the Kansas department of agriculture and 24 any other state agency."

(d) If a majority of the votes cast and counted are in opposition to allowing dairy production facilities to be established in such county, the county election officer shall transmit a copy of the result to the secretary of state who shall publish in the Kansas register the result of such election and that dairy production facilities are not allowed to be established in such county.

(e) If a majority of the votes cast and counted is in favor of the
proposition, the county election officer shall transmit a copy of the result
to the secretary of state who shall publish in the Kansas register the result
of such election and that dairy production facilities are allowed to be
established in such county.

(f) The election provided for by this section shall be conducted, and
the votes counted and canvassed, in the manner provided by law for
question submitted elections of the county.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 17-5908 is hereby amended to read as follows: 17-5908. (a) The board of county commissioners, by resolution, may submit to the qualified voters of the county a proposition to allow swineproduction facilities, as defined in K.S.A. 17-5903, and amendmentsthereto, to be established within the county. Upon adoption of such-

resolution, the county election officer shall submit the question of whether
 swine production facilities shall be allowed to be established in such county at the next state or county-wide regular or special election.

(b) (1) The board of county commissioners, upon a petition filed in
accordance with paragraph (b)(2), shall submit to the qualified voters of
the county a proposition to allow swine production facilities, as defined in
K.S.A. 17-5903, and amendments thereto, to be established within the
county.

9 (2) A petition to submit a proposition to the qualified voters of a 10 county pursuant to this subsection (b) shall be filed with the county 11 election officer. The petition shall be signed by qualified voters of the 12 county equal in number to not less than 5% of the voters of the county who 13 voted for the office of secretary of state at the last preceding general-14 election at which such office was elected. The following shall appear on 15 the petition:

16 "We request an election to determine whether corporate swine 17 production facilities shall be allowed to be established in \_\_\_\_\_ county,
 18 pursuant to K.S.A. 17-5904."

(3) Upon the submission of a valid petition calling for an election pursuant to this subsection, the county election officer shall submit the question of whether swine production facilities shall be allowed to be established in such county at the next state or county-wide regular orspecial election which occurs more than 60 days after the petition is filed with the county election officer.

(c) If a majority of the votes cast and counted are in opposition to allowing swine production facilities to be established in such county, the county election officer shall transmit a copy of the result to the secretary of state who shall publish in the Kansas register the result of such election and that swine production facilities are not allowed to be established in such county.

(d) If a majority of the votes cast and counted is in favor of the
proposition, the county election officer shall transmit a copy of the result
to the secretary of state who shall publish in the Kansas register the result
of such election and that swine production facilities are allowed to be
established in such county.

36 (e) The election provided for by this section shall be conducted, and 37 the votes counted and canvassed, in the manner provided by law for-38 question submitted elections of the county, except that the county election 39 officer shall publish in the official county newspaper a notice of such-40 election once each week for two consecutive weeks, the first publication to 41 be not less than 21 days before the election, and such notice shall state the 42 date and time of the election and the proposition that will appear on the 43 ballot. (a) (1) The board of county commissioners, by resolution, may

permit or deny a swine production facility, as defined in K.S.A. 17-5903,
 and amendments thereto, to be established within the county. Such
 resolution shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in
 the official county newspaper. The resolution shall take effect 60 days after
 final publication unless a valid petition in opposition to the same is filed.

6 (2) If within 60 days of the final publication of the resolution, a valid 7 protest petition to submit the resolution to the qualified voters of the 8 county is signed by qualified electors of the county equal in number to not less than 10% 5% of the electors of the county who voted for the office of 9 secretary of state at the last preceding general election at which such 10 office was elected and is filed with the county election officer, the county 11 12 election officer shall submit the question, as established in subsection (c), of whether a swine production facility shall be allowed to be established in 13 such county at the next countywide state, county or special election. 14

15 (b) (1) The board of county commissioners, upon a petition filed in 16 accordance with paragraph (b)(2), shall submit to the qualified electors of 17 the county a proposition to permit a swine production facility, as defined 18 in K.S.A. 17-5903, and amendments thereto, to be established within the 19 county.

20 (2) A petition to submit a proposition to the qualified voters of a 21 county pursuant to this section shall be filed with the county election 22 officer. The petition shall be signed by qualified electors of the county 23 equal in number to not less than 10% 5% of the electors of the county who 24 voted for the office of secretary of state at the last preceding general 25 election at which such office was elected. The following shall appear on 26 the petition:

27 "We request an election to determine whether a corporation, trust, 28 limited liability company, limited partnership or corporate partnership, other than a family farm corporation, authorized farm corporation, 29 limited liability agricultural company, limited agricultural partnership, 30 31 family trust, authorized trust or testamentary trust shall be allowed to, 32 either directly or indirectly, own, acquire or otherwise obtain or lease any 33 county for the purpose of establishing a agricultural land in 34 swine production facility."

(3) Upon the submission of a valid petition calling for an election
pursuant to this subsection, the county election officer shall submit the
question, as established in subsection (c), of whether a swine production
facility shall be allowed to be established in such county at the next
countywide election which occurs more than 60 days after the petition is
filed with the county election officer.

41 (c) In any election established pursuant to this section, the following
42 shall appear on the ballot:

partnership or corporate partnership, other than a family farm 1 corporation, authorized farm corporation, limited liability agricultural 2 3 company, limited agricultural partnership, family trust, authorized trust or 4 testamentary trust be allowed to, either directly or indirectly, own, acquire 5 or otherwise obtain or lease any agricultural land in county for 6 the purpose of establishing a swine production facility? Such facility shall 7 be in compliance with rules and regulations of the Kansas department 8 of health and environment, the Kansas department of agriculture and 9 any other state agency."

10 (d) If a majority of the votes cast and counted are in opposition to allowing swine production facilities to be established in such county, the 11 12 county election officer shall transmit a copy of the result to the secretary 13 of state who shall publish in the Kansas register the result of such election 14 and that swine production facilities are not allowed to be established in 15 such county.

16 (e) If a majority of the votes cast and counted is in favor of the 17 proposition, the county election officer shall transmit a copy of the result 18 to the secretary of state who shall publish in the Kansas register the result 19 of such election and that swine production facilities are allowed to be 20 established in such county.

21 (f) The election provided for by this section shall be conducted, and 22 the votes counted and canvassed, in the manner provided by law for 23 auestion submitted elections of the county. 24

K.S.A. 17-5907 and 17-5908 are hereby repealed. Sec. 3.
