AN ACT enacting the state government immigration accountability act.	

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

- Section 1. (a) On and after January 1, 2013, the state shall enroll and actively participate in e-verify for verification of employment status of all employees whose employment commences after January 1, 2013.
- (b) "E-verify" means an electronic system as jointly administered by the United States department of homeland security and the social security administration or its successor program, pursuant to 8 U.S.C. § 1324a, which is used to verify the employment authorization of employees.
- (c) The secretary of administration shall have responsibility for oversight of the e-verify program. The secretary shall present a detailed report on the implementation of such program to the legislature on or before January 15, 2014.
- (d) This section shall be cited as the state government immigration accountability act.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
