1 2	AN ACT concerning certain deductions from wages; amending K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 44-319 and repealing the existing section.
23	2011 Supp. 44-319 and repeating the existing section.
4	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:
5	Section 1. K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 44-319 is hereby amended to read as
6	follows: 44-319. (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), no employer
7	may withhold, deduct or divert any portion of an employee's wages unless:
8	(1) The employer is required or empowered to do so by state or
9	federal law;
10	(2) the deductions are for medical, surgical or hospital care or service,
11	without financial benefit to the employer, and are openly, clearly and in
12	due course recorded in the employer's books;
13	(3) the employer has a signed authorization by the employee for
14	deductions for a lawful purpose accruing to the benefit of the employee; or
15	(4) the deductions are for contributions attributable to automatic
16	enrollment, as defined in K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 44-319a, and amendments
17	thereto, in a retirement plan established by the employer described in
18	sections 401(k), 403(b), 408, 408A or 457 of the internal revenue code.
19	(b) An employer may withhold, deduct or divert any portion of an
20	employee's wages for the following purposes:
21	(1) To allow the employee to repay a loan or advance which the
22	employer made to the employee during the course of and within the scope
23	of employment;
24	(2) to allow for recovery of payroll overpayment;
25	(3) to compensate the employer for the value of the employer's
26	merchandise or uniforms purchased by the employee; and
27	(4) to compensate the employer for breakage, loss or return of
28	merchandise, inventory shortage or cash shortage caused by the employee
29	where the employee was the sole party responsible for the cash or items
30	damaged or lost at the time the damage or loss occurred.
31	(c) Nothing in this section shall be construed as prohibiting the
32	withholding of amounts authorized in writing by the employee to be
33	contributed by the employee to charitable organizations; nor shall this
34	section prohibit deductions by check-off of dues to labor organizations or
35	service fees, where such is not otherwise prohibited by law. Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 44-319 is hereby repealed.
36	Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 44-519 is nereby repeated.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 1 2 3 publication in the statute book.
