1 AN ACT concerning the state directory of new hires; relating to
2 information submitted by employers; amending K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 75-
3 5743 and repealing the existing section.

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5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 75-5743 is hereby amended to read as
7 follows: 75-5743. (a) All employers and labor organizations doing
8 business in this state shall submit information concerning each ~~new~~ newly
9 hired employee to the secretary of labor within 20 days of the hiring,
10 rehiring or return to work of the newly hired employee or within 20 days
11 from the date the newly hired employee first receives wages or other
12 compensation from the employer. The information shall include the newly
13 hired employee's name, address ~~and social security number~~, social security
14 number and the date services for remuneration were first performed by the
15 newly hired employee and the employer's name, address and federal tax
16 identification number as well as any other information required by section
17 453A of the social security act, 42 U.S.C. § 653a, and amendments
18 thereto.

19 (b) For the purposes of this section, "newly hired employee" means
20 an employee who:

21 (1) Has not been previously employed by the employer; or

22 (2) has been previously employed by the employer but has been
23 separated from such prior employment for at least 60 consecutive days.

24 (b) (c) The department of social and rehabilitation services shall have
25 access to such information to match the employee's social security number
26 with title IV-D cases.

27 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 75-5743 is hereby repealed.

28 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
29 publication in the statute book.
