1	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION endorsing Taiwan's participation as
2	an observer in the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO)
3	and United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change
4	(UNFCCC).
5	WHEREAS, Civil aviation plays a pivotal role in promoting cultural
6	exchange, business, trade and tourism; and
7	WHEREAS, The development of international civil aviation in a safe
8	and orderly manner is the supreme cause of the International Civil
9	Aviation Organization (ICAO); and
10	WHEREAS, Taiwan is the world's 20th largest economy, the 18th
11	largest trading country and a key air transport hub linking Northeast and
12	Southeast Asia; and
13	WHEREAS, Over 174,000 international flights travel to and from
14	Taiwan, with foreign passengers making around 3.8 million trips to the
15	island every year and over 35 million passengers, including 25.39 million
16	passengers on international flights, arrived and departed from Taiwan's
17	airports in 2008; and
18	WHEREAS, Without Taiwan's participation, international flight plans,
19	regulations and procedures that the ICAO formulates will be incomplete
20	and unsafe: Now, therefore,
21	Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Kansas,
22	the Senate concurring therein: That the Kansas legislature endorses
23	Taiwan's participation in the International Civil Aviation Organization as
24	an observer; and
25	Be it further resolved: That the Kansas legislature is supportive of all
26	efforts to grant Taiwan official observer status at the United Nations
27	Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC); and
28	Be it further resolved: That copies of this resolution be sent to the
29	United States Secretary of State, the United States Secretary of
30	Transportation and to each member of the Kansas Congressional
31	Delegation and to the Director-General of the Taipei Economic and
32	Cultural Office in Kansas City.
