4	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:
5	Section 1. K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 65-1817 is hereby amended to read as
6	follows: 65-1817. (a) In each fiscal year, the board shall determine the
7	amount of funds which will be required during the next ensuing fiscal
8	year to properly administer the laws which the board is directed to
9	enforce and administer and shall fix fees in accordance with this section
10	for such ensuing year in such reasonable sums as may be necessary for
11	such purposes.
12	(b) After fixing such fees, the board may charge and collect the fees,

8	(c) A duplicate license will be issued upon the filing of a statement
9	covering the loss of same and the payment of a fee of \$5 for the issuance

12	Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 65-1817 is hereby repealed.
13	Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
14	publication in the statute book.
