1 AN ACT concerning board of barbering; relating to fees; amending K.S.A.
2 2010 Supp. 65-1817 and repealing the existing section.

4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

5 Section 1. K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 65-1817 is hereby amended to read as
6 follows: 65-1817. (a) In each fiscal year, the board shall determine the
7 amount of funds which will be required during the next ensuing fiscal year
8 to properly administer the laws which the board is directed to enforce and
9 administer and shall fix fees in accordance with this section for such
10 ensuing year in such reasonable sums as may be necessary for such
11 purposes.

12 (b) After fixing such fees, the board may charge and collect the fees,
13 in advance for the following purposes, subject to the following limitations:

14 For examination of applicant to practice barbering—not more than~~\$100~~120

15 For issuance of license to practice barbering—not more than~~80~~100

16 For renewal of license to practice barbering—not more than~~80~~100

17 For restoration of expired license to practice barbering, if expiration period is
18 under three years, the lapsed fees plus a restoration fee of not more
19 than..... 100

20 After three years applicant shall be reexamined upon payment of the regular
21 examination fee—not more than~~100~~120

22 For instructors license or annual renewal thereof—not more than~~90~~130

23 For restoration of expired instructors license, if expiration period is under three
24 years, the lapsed fees plus a restoration fee of not more than~~90~~130

25 After three years the instructor shall be reexamined upon payment of the regular
26 examination fee—not more than~~170~~190

27 For a license to operate a barber school or barber college, annual fee—not more
28 than500

29 For shop inspection, and annual license fee—not more than~~4050~~ 60

30 For restoration of expired shop license, if expiration period is under three years,
31 the lapsed fee plus a restoration fee of not more than80

32 For a new shop, relocation or change of ownership—not more than~~80~~100

33 *For issuance of new chair lease license or annual renewal thereof—not more than*
34~~50~~ 40

35 *For restoration of expired chair lease license, if expiration period is under three*
36 *years, the lapsed fees plus a restoration fee of not more than.....~~50~~ 60*

1 For issuance of a seminar permit—not more than80

2 For issuance of student learning license—not more than5565

3 (c) A duplicate license will be issued upon the filing of a statement
4 covering the loss of same and the payment of a fee of \$5 for the issuance
5 of same. Each duplicate shall have the word "duplicate" stamped across
6 the face thereof and will bear the same number as the original.

7 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 65-1817 is hereby repealed.

8 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
9 publication in the statute book.
