

House Substitute for SENATE BILL No. 191

By Agriculture and Natural Resources Budget Committee

1 AN ACT making and concerning appropriations for the fiscal year ending
2 June 30, 2012, for {concerning the} Kansas department of agriculture;
3 authorizing certain transfers, fees, imposing certain restrictions and
4 limitations, and directing or authorizing certain receipts, disbursements,
5 procedures and acts incidental to the foregoing {fees; creating the
6 laboratory testing services fee fund}.

8 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

9 Section 1. (a) For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012, appropriations
10 are hereby made, restrictions and limitations are hereby imposed, and
11 transfers, capital improvement projects, fees, receipts, disbursements and
12 acts incidental to the foregoing are hereby directed or authorized as
13 provided in this act.

14 (b) This act shall not be subject to the provisions of subsection (a) of
15 K.S.A. 75-6702, and amendments thereto.

17 KANSAS DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE

18 (a) There is appropriated for the above agency from the following
19 special revenue fund or funds for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012, all
20 moneys now or hereafter lawfully credited to and available in such fund or
21 funds, except that expenditures other than refunds authorized by law shall
22 not exceed the following:

23 Laboratory testing services fee fund.....No limit

24 Provided, That all expenditures from the laboratory testing services fee
25 fund shall be for the purposes of providing laboratory testing of samples
26 from other states upon request: Provided further, That the secretary of
27 agriculture is hereby authorized to fix, charge and collect fees for such
28 laboratory testing: And provided further, That such fees shall be fixed in
29 order to recover all or part of the costs incurred to provide the services and
30 any other necessary and incidental expenses incurred in conjunction with
31 such laboratory testing: And provided further, That all moneys received
32 for such fees shall be deposited in the state treasury in accordance with the
33 provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto, and shall be
34 credited to the laboratory testing services fee fund: And provided further,
35 That the secretary of agriculture may adopt rules and regulations to
36 establish fees and to implement and administer the provisions of this section

2 **charge and collect fees for providing laboratory testing of samples**
3 **from other states upon request. The fees shall be fixed in order to**
4 **recover all or part of the costs incurred to provide the services and**

7 **{(b) The secretary of agriculture shall remit all moneys received**
8 **by or for the secretary from fees collected under this section to the**
9 **state treasurer in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215,**
10 **and amendments thereto. Upon receipt of each such remittance, the**
11 **state treasurer shall deposit the entire amount in the state treasury to**
12 **the credit of the laboratory testing services fee fund.}**

13 **{(c) The secretary of agriculture may adopt rules and regulations**
14 **to establish fees and to implement and administer the provisions of**
15 **this section for such laboratory testing.}**
