AN ACT concerning state officers and employees; relating to state universities; relating to certain negotiated contracts.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of K.S.A. 46-215 through 46-293 and K.S.A. 46-237a, and amendments thereto, an employee of a state university may provide significant factual information or advice or recommendations in relation to the negotiated terms of a technology licensing agreement or other research or development agreement between the state university and a company in which the employee has a substantial interest, provided that the employee does not have the authority to negotiate the terms of such agreement, or to approve such agreement on behalf of the state university.

- (b) For the purposes of this section, the phrase "research or development" means those activities and services relating to the development, transfer or commercialization of technology or other intellectual property.
- (c) This section shall be a part of and supplemental to the state governmental ethics law.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
