1 AN ACT concerning state board of education member districts; providing  
2 for the redistricting thereof; repealing K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 4-514, 4-515,  
3 4-516, 4-517, 4-518, 4-519, 4-520, 4-521, 4-522, 4-523, 4-524 and 4-  
4 525.

6 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

7 Section 1. In accordance with section 3 of article 6 of the constitution  
8 of the state of Kansas, the state of Kansas is divided into ten state board of  
9 education member districts.

10 Sec. 2. The senatorial districts referred to in sections 3 through 12,  
11 and amendments thereto, are those senatorial districts established by 2012  
12 House Bill No. 2606.

13 Sec. 3. State board of education member district one shall consist of  
14 senatorial districts 3, 4, 5 and 6.

15 Sec. 4. State board of education member district two shall consist of  
16 senatorial districts 7, 8, 10 and 11.

17 Sec. 5. State board of education member district three shall consist of  
18 senatorial districts 9, 23, 37 and 38.

19 Sec. 6. State board of education member district four shall consist of  
20 senatorial districts 2, 18, 19 and 20.

21 Sec. 7. State board of education member district five shall consist of  
22 senatorial districts 33, 36, 39 and 40.

23 Sec. 8. State board of education member district six shall consist of  
24 senatorial districts 1, 21, 22 and 24.

25 Sec. 9. State board of education member district seven shall consist of  
26 senatorial districts 17, 31, 34 and 35.

27 Sec. 10. State board of education member district eight shall consist  
28 of senatorial districts 25, 28, 29 and 30.

29 Sec. 11. State board of education member district nine shall consist of  
30 senatorial districts 12, 13, 14 and 15.

31 Sec. 12. State board of education member district ten shall consist of  
32 senatorial districts 16, 26, 27 and 32.

33 Sec. 13. K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 4-514, 4-515, 4-516, 4-517, 4-518, 4-519,  
34 4-520, 4-521, 4-522, 4-523, 4-524 and 4-525 are hereby repealed.

35 Sec. 14. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
36 publication in the Kansas register.
