Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. In accordance with section 3 of article 6 of the constitution of the state of Kansas, the state of Kansas is divided into ten state board of education member districts.

- The senatorial districts referred to in sections 3 through 12, and amendments thereto, are those senatorial districts established by 2012 House Bill No. 2606.
- State board of education member district one shall consist of Sec. 3. senatorial districts 3, 4, 5 and 6.
- 15 State board of education member district two shall consist of 16 senatorial districts 7, 8, 10 and 11.
- 17 State board of education member district three shall consist of 18 senatorial districts 9, 23, 37 and 38.
- 19 State board of education member district four shall consist of Sec. 6. 20 senatorial districts 2, 18, 19 and 20.
- 21 State board of education member district five shall consist of 22 senatorial districts 33, 36, 39 and 40.
 - State board of education member district six shall consist of Sec. 8. senatorial districts 1, 21, 22 and 24.
- 25 State board of education member district seven shall consist of 26 senatorial districts 17, 31, 34 and 35.
- 27 Sec. 10. State board of education member district eight shall consist 28 of senatorial districts 25, 28, 29 and 30.
- 29 Sec. 11. State board of education member district nine shall consist of 30 senatorial districts 12, 13, 14 and 15.
- 31 State board of education member district ten shall consist of 32 senatorial districts 16, 26, 27 and 32.
- 33 K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 4-514, 4-515, 4-516, 4-517, 4-518, 4-519, 34
 - 4-520, 4-521, 4-522, 4-523, 4-524 and 4-525 are hereby repealed.
- 35 This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 36 publication in the Kansas register.
