Repeal of Statutes on Fraudulent Sales Practices; HB 2626

HB 2626 repeals two statutes (KSA 83-139 and KSA 83-140) concerning fraudulent practices in selling grain, seed, hay, or coal. The statutes address the practice of a purchaser deducting a quantity from the actual weight or measure of the article purchased and withholding payment for that amount by reason of custom, rule of a board of trade, or for other reason, without an express agreement with the seller. The statutes also set out penalties, civil liabilities, and responsibility for attorney fees.
