SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2227

As Recommended by House Committee on Corrections and Juvenile Justice

Brief*

HB 2227 would amend KSA 22-2304 to allow issuance of warrants identifying a defendant by a description of the defendant's DNA, rather than by name, when the defendant's name is unknown.

Background

In the House Committee on Corrections and Juvenile Justice, a representative of the Kansas Association of Chiefs of Police, Kansas Sheriffs Association, and the Kansas Peace Officers Association offered testimony in support of the bill. No opponents offered testimony.

The fiscal note indicates that passage of HB 2227 would have no fiscal effect.
