SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2429

As Recommended by House Committee on
Education Budget

Brief*

HB 2429 would remove the expiration date on the State Education Institution Project Delivery Construction Procurement Act, which applies only to university construction projects and services funded totally with non-state money. (The Act is due to expire on June 30, 2012.)

Background

Representatives from the American Council of Engineering Companies (ACEC), the Kansas Chapter of the American Institute of Architects, the University of Kansas, and Kansas State University provided testimony in support of the bill.

A representative from the Associated General Contractors (AGC) spoke in opposition to the bill.

The Division of the Budget fiscal note indicates there would be no fiscal effect for the Department of Administration.

Any fiscal effect for the universities is not reflected in the *FY 2013 Governor's Budget Report*.
