SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2670

As Recommended by House Committee on Government Efficiency

Brief*

HB 2670 would repeal a statute concerning certain duties of the county clerk as to land abstracts. KSA 79-414 requires the county clerk to obtain an abstract of lands entered after January 1 of the previous year from the land office and to enter unlisted lands on the tax rolls.

Background

The bill was introduced at the request of the Governor's Office of the Repealer. The Secretary of Administration testified in favor of the bill before the House Committee on Government Efficiency indicating the statute is out-of-date and no longer practical. The Secretary indicated reappraisal enacted in 1989 requires county appraisers to maintain appraisal maps pursuant to KSA 79-1459. No opposing or neutral testimony was presented to the House Committee.

The fiscal note prepared by the Division of the Budget states the bill is of a technical nature; therefore, enactment of the bill would have no fiscal effect.
