### **SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 118**

# As Amended by House Committee of the Whole

### **Brief\***

House Sub. for SB 118 would amend a section of law dealing with legislative page compensation and allow the Director of Legislative Administrative Services to pay legislative pages a remuneration having a value of not less than \$5. Any remuneration having a value of more than \$5 would require Legislative Coordinating Council approval.

The bill would be in effect upon publication in the Kansas Register.

## **Background**

This bill contains the provisions of HB 2733. At the hearing on HB 2733, the Committee heard from the Director of Legislative Administrative Services. He stated the cost of processing each check for legislative pages was \$6.00 not counting the cost of postage or the actual \$3 amount of the check. He proposed providing a coupon worth \$3 which could be redeemed at the snack bar in the Capitol. Pages would continue to receive the certificate of recognition for service as they currently do.

The House Committee on Calendar and Printing heard the bill would result in a savings of over \$8,300 a year.

The House Committee of the Whole amended the bill to increase the minimum remuneration from \$3 to \$5 and require that any remuneration having a value of more than \$5 would require the approval of the Legislative Coordinating Council.
