1	A RESOLUTION encouraging participation in the American
2	Public Health Association's and the Kansas Public Health
3	Association's National Public Health Week, which is April 4-10, 2011.
4	WHEREAS, The week of April 4-10, 2011 is National Public Health
5	Week, and the theme is "Safety is no Accident: Live Injury-Free"; and
6	WHEREAS, Kansas counties and local health departments play a vital
7	role in the state's public health; and
8	WHEREAS, Since 1995, the American Public Health Association,
9	through its sponsorship of National Public Health Week, has educated the
10	public, policy-makers and public health professionals about public health
11	issues; and
12	
13	WHEREAS, Each year, nearly 150,000 people die from injuries.
14	Unintentional injuries, such as motor vehicle crashes, poisonings and falls
15	rank among the top 10 causes of death for people ages 1-44; and
16	WHEREAS, Almost 30 million people are injured seriously enough to
17	go to the emergency room each year; and
18	WHEREAS, The financial costs of injuries are staggering, accounting
19	for 12% of annual medical care spending and totaling as much as \$69
20	billion per year; and
21	WHEREAS, Injuries, unexpected events and violence affect people at
22	home, at work, in their communities, on the move and even at play; and
23	WHEREAS, Many injuries and associated costs can be proactively
24	prevented by taking actions such as wearing a seat belt, properly
25	installing smoke alarms, correctly installing and using child safety seats,
26	wearing a helmet, and storing cleaning supplies in locked cabinets.
27	Furthermore, educating the community about violence and maltreatment
28	towards children, seniors and other vulnerable populations prevents
29	injuries: Now, therefore,
30	Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Kansas:
31	That we support the efforts of the American Public Health Association and
32	the Kansas Public Health Association. Specifically, we recognize the week
33	of April 4-10, 2011, as National Public Health Week in Kansas. We call
34	upon the people of Kansas to observe this week by helping our families,
35	friends, neighbors, co-workers and leaders better understand the
36	importance of public health to a successful health system by remembering
