## 2012 Kansas Statutes

- **40-5505. Requirements.** (a) Before issuing a public adjuster license to an applicant under this act, the commissioner shall find that the applicant:
- (1) Is eligible to designate this state as the applicant's home state or is a nonresident who is not eligible for a license under K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 40-5508, and amendments thereto;
- (2) has not committed any act that is a ground for denial, suspension or revocation of a license as set forth in K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 40-5510, and amendments thereto;
- (3) is trustworthy, reliable and of good reputation, evidence of which may be determined by the commissioner;
- (4) is financially responsible to exercise the rights and privileges under the license and has provided proof of financial responsibility as required in K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 40-5511, and amendments thereto;
  - (5) has paid an application fee of \$100; and
- (6) maintains an office in the home state with public access during regular business hours or by reasonable appointment.
  - (b) In addition to satisfying the requirements of subsection (a), an applicant shall:
  - (1) Be at least 18 years of age; and
  - (2) have successfully passed the public adjuster examination.
- (c) The commissioner may require any documents reasonably necessary to verify the information contained in the application.
