Lawrence Virtual High School (LVHS) is a program of the Lawrence School district in Lawrence, Kansas.

Lawrence Virtual High School uses the nationally-acclaimed K¹² Curriculum.

Lawrence Virtual High School serves students in grades 9- 12 during the 2012-2013 school year and this will be LVHS's first year with a senior class.

As of January 2013, LVHS has 240 enrolled students.

Lawrence Virtual High School serves students throughout the state of Kansas.

The students of Lawrence Virtual High School resemble the public school population of Kansas.

The LVHS program includes full service academic programs and provides the continuum of services to students.

Lawrence Virtual High School provides instruction to students with 11 regular education teachers, three advisors, a counselor and special education teacher. New teachers participate in a two week virtual training program and three days of in-person training prior to the start of school. Teachers participate in weekly staff meetings, monthly National Professional Development with K12 and quarterly school-based professional development throughout the school year.

Lawrence Virtual High School supports faculty and families with a Head of School, High School Director, Operations Manager and Registrar.

Teachers work with our advisors and counselor to schedule monthly field trips and activities for families.

LVHS hosts several virtual clubs locally including yearbook, health and fitness and student government.

This spring, LVHS will host its first prom and graduation ceremony at our school building in Lawrence, Kansas.
