Kansas Farmers Union stands in opposition to HB2241.

Kansas Farmers Union supports conservation as the major effort to reduce energy requirements. We support the research and development of renewable energy resources such as solar, geothermal, wind, hydrogen, ethanol, biodiesel, and algae with emphasis on community-owned wind generated power.

KFU supports a resilient expanded electrical grid system that allows for dependable transmission nationwide. We support a 15% renewable energy mandate for electrical generation. We also support securing 25% of the nation's energy utilization from renewable sources by 2025 (25X25).

We support the Renewable Portfolio Standard established by the Kansas Renewable Standards Act and we support renewal of the national Renewable Energy Production Tax Credit.
