

**TESTIMONY BEFORE

**REGARDING HOUSE BILL 2145
RELATING TO REPEALING K.S.A 75-5028**

Mr. Chairman and Committee Members:

Thank you for allowing the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) to provide written testimony in support of House Bill 2145. HB 2145 relating to repealing K.S.A. 75-5028 is an item submitted by the agency to the Office of the Repealer in an attempt to clean-up the state statutes that are outdated or no longer necessary. The agency believes this statute is no longer needed.

K.S.A. 75-5028 was passed in 1978 and authorized the sale of one certain piece of land in Pottawatomie County. Following the conclusion of this sale, the statute no longer had a useful purpose.

Currently the agency sells property pursuant to K.S.A. 68-413.
