

## KANSAS BOARD OF REGENTS

## Senate Federal and State Affairs SB 186 Andy Tompkins, CEO and President March 14, 2013

Chairman Ostmeyer and members of the Senate Federal and State Affairs Committee, the Kansas Board of Regents submits this testimony regarding SB 186, which amends the Personal and Family Protection Act.

The Kansas Board of Regents supports the local control concept in the bill and is neutral on the rest of SB 186.

SB 186 allows the governing body or chief administrative officer to exempt out of section 1 of the bill for 4 years by doing the following:

- 1. Adopt a resolution
- 2. Draft a letter providing the legal descriptions of the building to be exempted and the reason for the exemption
- 3. Include a copy of the security plan for the buildings
- 4. Submit a notice of the exemptions and a copy of the resolution to the Kansas Attorney General
