MADAM PRESIDENT:

I move to amend **SB** 63, as amended by Senate Committee, on page 1, following line 6, by inserting:

"New Section 1. (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), the secretary of state shall not knowingly establish any political committee, a major purpose of which is to expressly advocate the nomination, election or defeat of a clearly identified candidate for the legislature or statewide office or make contributions or expenditures for the nomination, election or defeat of a clearly identified candidate for the legislature or a statewide office.

- (b) The provisions of this section shall not apply to any political committee which is established to expressly advocate for the election of a candidate for the office of secretary of state or to make contributions or expenditures for the election of a candidate for the office of secretary of state.
 - (c) Violation of this section is a class C misdemeanor.
- (d) Any political committee currently in existence, which is in violation of subsection (a), is hereby abolished.";
