MR. CHAIRMAN:

I move to amend **SB 274**, as amended by Senate Committee of the Whole, on page 1, following line 14, by inserting:

"New Sec. 2. (a) No political committee, a major purpose of which is to expressly advocate the nomination, election or defeat of a clearly identified candidate for the legislature or statewide office, or to make contributions or expenditures for the nomination, election or defeat of a clearly identified candidate for the legislature or a statewide office, shall be established by the secretary of state. Any such political committee currently in existence is hereby abolished.

- (b) At the time of the termination of any political committee established by the secretary of state, all residual funds not otherwise obligated for the payment of expenses incurred shall be:
 - (1) Contributed to a charitable organization, as defined by the laws of the state;
 - (2) contributed to a party committee;
- (3) returned as a refund in whole or in part to any contributor or contributors from whom such funds were received; or
 - (4) paid into the general fund of the state.";
