SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2094 by House Committee on Vision 2020

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2094 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2094 would prohibit any public or private postsecondary educational institution from requiring or requesting a student or prospective student to disclose the existence of a personal account or its contents or access a personal account. The bill lists exceptions to this requirement. Those exceptions would include investigating allegations of misconduct, accessing an institutional computer, conducting background checks for purposes of employment or certain courses, and when high-risk behavior is being exhibited. The educational institution could not dismiss, discipline, penalize or retaliate against a student for not disclosing information.

Enactment of HB 2094 would have no fiscal effect.
